



Manage your health with HIV self-test

HIV self-testing is an antibody test, which can take 23 to 90 days (about 4 to 12 weeks) to detect HIV infection after exposure.

More often to get tested if increased risk of getting HIV



More information on screening and other services

1. Unprotected sexual intercourse: be tested at least once a year
2. Sexually active: get tested for HIV at least once
3. For those at higher risk or their sexual partners (e.g. sharing needles or diluent, multiple sexual partners, drug use, and STD): get tested every 3–6 months

Positive result

If test shows BOTH the Control Line AND Test Line

Present a photo of your test kit serial number at the clinic to receive an exemption for copayment and registration fee for the clinic visit and a refund of \$200 for the test kit.

- An positive result (antibody positive) means you may have been infected with HIV. You need to follow up with a health care professional to confirm the test result. It is recommended that you visit an HIV designated hospital for further confirmation test even when you are asymptomatic.

Negative result

- This may be in the window period. It is recommended that you avoid high-risk events and perform regular testing.
- To prevent infection, please use condoms consistently and use water-based lubricants. Do not share needles, or use thinners or drugs. Alternatively, use pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP).

PrEP is a medication proven to be effective for preventing HIV when taken following a physician's assessment. Please scan the QR-code for more information.

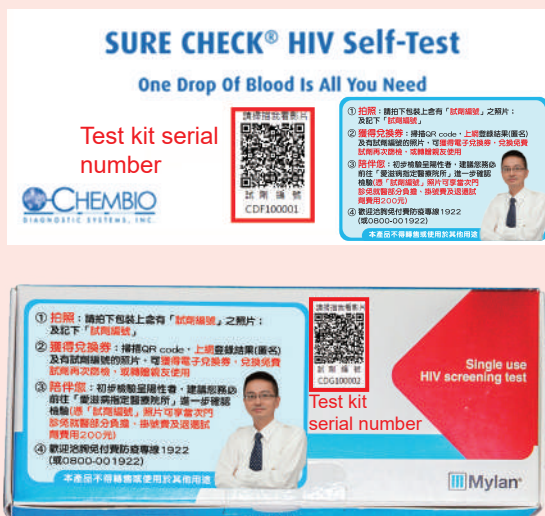

Report test result (anonymous)

01 Take a photo of the test kit serial number on the box.



02 Report your test result online to receive a coupon for a free self-test kit or enter a lucky draw.



Method 1

Scan the QR-code on the package of the self-testing kit with your smartphone or tablet to automatically fill in the serial number.

Method 2

Visit the self-test website/ submit test results to receive a self-test kit coupon and enter a lucky draw, enter the self-test kit serial number (<https://reurl.cc/WXd0G7>).

Report test result

03 Complete the online questionnaire and upload a photo clearly showing the test kit serial number.

(Supported image formats: JPG, PNG, BMP, and HEIC)

04 After approval, the system will send out an electronic coupon to your account (verify and log in to your account to see the coupon).
